Sale of Second-Hand Books

This is a reminder of the Book Sale which is taking place in the Morley House Library next week.

If you have not yet brought your good quality fiction or non-fiction books, suitable for children in Nursery to Year 6, it is not too late. **Please bring them in on Monday.** These will then be sorted and sold for prices ranging from 25p-£1.50. If you are happy for your child to select their own book (with some adult assistance) they should **bring in their money in a labelled envelope on Tuesday.**
