Each year the LOGS PTA generously funds a Bikeability course for all the children in Year 5. You probably remember this course as the Cycling Proficiency Test. Bikeability is designed to give the next generation the skills and confidence to ride their bikes more often and more safely on today's roads. The course begins with a safety check on each bike followed by a session in the playground where control skills are assessed. This is followed by on-road sessions on the roads around the school and completes Level 2 training. This year, three Year 6 children joined the course as they were not able to complete the course last year. We feel that this is a valuable addition to our extra-curricular activities and builds on the road awareness course offered to Year 1 and Year 2 earlier in the year. We are very grateful to the PTA for their continued support.

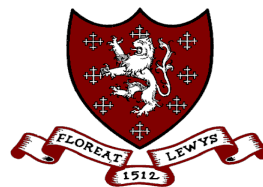

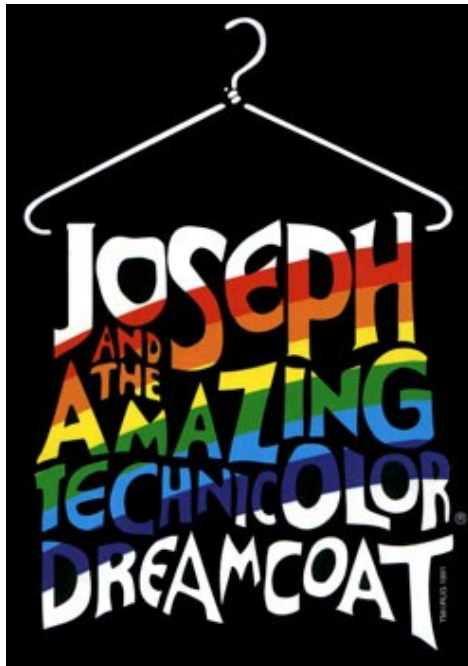
Music News!
